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Dear David

Many thanks for your two excellent letters re: Crosby/Green Gathering.

As you are no doubt well aware, I am in full agreement with almost everything you say. If you have had rather a silent response, I should interpret that as silent agreement. The carryover effect is very strange - after the 1983 debate I spoke to many people on the subject - If you remember it was an obsession of mine at the time. In private the overwhelming majority of people expressed general dismay, but unable to clear the subject in their minds, and somehow fearful of appearing "not properly green" most would not state their preference openly.

I have only two things to add to what you have

said. ① That the police are obviously quite glad of the existence of the Convoy Effect - since their job of controlling large gatherings in Connolly made a lot easier. In order to maintain credibility tho', they do from time to time have to send in the heavy brigade, but after a bit of smashing and shouting let everyone go again. I do not have sufficient evidence myself to put the case clearly - I'm sure you have! There is no doubt in my mind that if the police wanted to break up the Convoy for good, they could do it quite easily, even acting ~~the~~ within the law.

② The majority of people who make up the "Convoy" at any one time, when approached individually, would agree that the "Convoy" was not a good idea. People just get caught up in the romance / lack of money / sense of worthiness of being on the road. Of concerted propaganda effort including GL. too is needed to win the argument.

Details of the wreckage left by the Convoy must become public knowledge. So long as individuals are not named, you will find few who will support the ^{Convoy} action.

As regards my involvement in organising International event:- I am now so heavily committed with baby / SDP jeans / etc that I could not offer a major hand. My personal feelings are that the change to green consciousness is taking place quite satisfactorily - not as fast as we'd like, of course, but certainly visibly.

The things which tend to accelerate the change, tend to be events, and knowledge of events. The things that tend to slow it down tend to be bad publicity and loss of credibility.

One final point: How are ya going to stop some members of the collective inviting the Convoy? I have spoken with Marjorie on the subject, and she says that the same thing happened to them at Longfam — some people invited the Convoy — the Convoy turned up & posted posters saying "Green Deserts Welcomes the Peace Convoy" — QD lost them and by having to provide wood etc. later several ~~years~~ returned to the rate for the water, and the rate was lost. A question that often plagues

me is this - why do Conway members return to
federal sites? - why not to any old field?
It's as tho' there's a built-in death wish
in the mentality. I can't put words into
the way I interpret this - but it gives me
a vibe, (a vibe, unfortunately that I find inside
the Green Collective as well). I suppose if I am
truthful I would say that in my opinion the
efforts of the Green Collective have at best a marginal,
and at worst a negative effect on the green
consciousness. However, while there are still
members of it like yourself who are prepared
to ruffle the mud and the insects & try to
make it positive, I give you my blessing and
perhaps even a little help.

I hope that doesn't sound patronizing - it
not meant to be.
