

HUNTINGDON GREEN GROUP CONSTITUTION

AIMS

- i The promotion of green principles, broadly as expressed in 'The Greens Are Gathering' leaflet.
- ii The collection of information and data to assist in the promotion of such principles.
- iii Co-operation with other groups, as necessary, to build a broad local base for the green movement.
- iv The launching of practical projects to develop a green way of life.
- v To take whatever action is felt necessary in the furtherance of these aims.

MEMBERSHIP

- i We cover the old county of Huntingdonshire but membership is open to anyone who pays the appropriate subscription fee and subscribes to the principles of the group.
- ii A membership can be revoked by a simple majority vote at any meeting.

MEETINGS

- i They may be called by any member of the group.
- ii At least two weeks notice will be given of any meeting.
- iii There shall be a quorum of five.
- iv They will be chaired on a rotating principle.
- v All members are entitled to one vote but normally decision taking will be by consensus.
- vi Any member can give her/his proxy vote to another member. No member is allowed to carry more than two proxies to a meeting. It will be up to the chairperson to check any proxy votes.
- vii An Annual General Meeting shall be held once a year. All members will be invited and a Treasurer will be elected, together with other officers, as agreed by the group.

CONSTITUTION

- i This constitution may be revised by a two thirds majority of members voting at any authorised meeting.

This constitution was approved at a Hunts Greens meeting held on November 3rd 1983 at the Falcon Inn in Huntingdon.
