The Ecology Party is fielding 53 candidates at the General Election, I9 of these will be in the South West.

The Ecology Party is a new political party and it exists to provide an alternative to the centrimalised growth orientated policies of the major parties. We are facing a crisis -permanent inflation, chronic unemployment, high levels of taxation, continuing balance of trade difficulties and the threat of international recession. Whole communities are being broken apart by the pressures of 'economin necessity'; many feel lonely, streaaful and alienated. Political and social realities are seen in economic terms, compassion itself has become an item of public expenditure. Personal, social and even meligious values have been forced to yield before an overwhelmingly materialistic view of things.We seem to have lost the ability to respond sensitively, both to each other and to the world around us.

Ecology is the study of living things and the way in which they intereact.Simple though it may sound, this amounts to the most fundamental political reality of all. Without a full understanding of where we fit in, of the need to live in harmony with each other and the mest of creation -within the limitations of the earth's finite supply of resources- there is little between us and eventual extinction.

This awareness goes deeper than the narrow minded confrontations of left and right and it needs a new political initiative. Our programme rests on six fundamental changes:-

i) A move towards a sustainable way of life, conserving the earth's 'capital', learning to rely on those resources which can be renewed or recycled.

2) A move towards a stable economy, ensuring basic material security and prosperity for all.

3) A move towards economic self-sufficiency in terms of the basic necessities of life, particularly food and energy.

4) A move towards a de-centralised way of life, so that people may become more responsible for themselves and for others.

5) A move towards seeing things in the long term, rather than settling for convenient, short-term measures.

6) A move towards a society which places less emphasis on material values, and more on personal development and achievement.
